

**Friedrich Paulsen** is professor and chairman of the Department of Functional and Clinical Anatomy at FAU Erlangen-Nürnberg, Germany. He is specialist in gross anatomy as well as histology and editor of the SOBOTTA-atlas and SOBOTTA-textbook of Human Anatomy. He serves as Secretary of Anatomische Gesellschaft, is Secretary General of the IFAA, treasurer of the EFEM, Editor-in-Chief of the Annals of Anatomy and editorial board member of several biomedical journals. Dr. Paulsen obtained his medical degree at CAU Kiel, Germany, worked as researcher in Bristol, UK and was from 2004-2010 professor of anatomy at MLU Halle-Wittenberg, Germany, until he became head of the Department of Anatomy in Erlangen. Currently he is Vice President/Rector of FAU. His main research interests belong to innate immunity at mucosal surfaces especially at the ocular surface, tears, larynx, articulated joints and anatomical education.
