



ERNEST F. TALARICO, JR., Ph.D., is Associate Professor of Anatomy & Cell Biology at the Indiana University School of Medicine - Northwest (Gary, IN). Dr. Talarico holds joint appointments as Associate Faculty in the Department of Radiologic Sciences at Indiana University Northwest, and Visiting Professor at Tan Tao University School of Medicine (Việt Nam). He has researched human anatomy and anatomy education for over 20 years. Dr. Talarico has authored various basic science and educational research papers and book chapters

including *Commemorations and Memorials – Exploring the Human Face of Anatomy*, *Atlas of Gynecologic Oncology: Investigation and Surgery*, and *Practical Handbook of Advanced Interventional Cardiology (Angiographic Views)*. He is creator of the “Talarico Protocol for Human Gross Anatomy” that is a change in paradigm - giving back identity to donors in the anatomy laboratory. Further, he created and served as director for *the International Human Cadaver Prosection Program* and the Cadaver-Based Medical Imaging Program, which in 2008 received the award for most outstanding and innovative programs in undergraduate and continuing medical education from the AAMC Central Group on Educational Affairs. His professional memberships include the *American Association of Anatomists*, the *American Association of Clinical Anatomists*, the *Association for Research in Vision and Ophthalmology*, and the *International Society for Eye Research*. He serves as a referee for various anatomy and radiology journals, and as an associate editor for the *European Journal of Anatomy*. Dr. Talarico also serves as the director of the Anatomy Project in Việt Nam and Southeast Asia; consulting and revising anatomy curricula and laboratory facilities.
