Rodrigo Enrique Elizondo Omaña, M.D., Ph.D., was born on May 23, 1980 in Monterrey, Nuevo León. He earned his medical degree (M.D.) at the school of medicine Facultad de Medicina of the Universidad Autonoma de Nuevo León from 1996 to 2003. He completed his doctoral studies in science in the same institution from 2004 to 2008; He completed his Doctorate in Medicine at the Universidad Complutense de Madrid from 2008 to 2010 with the distinction of Outstanding Cum Laude.

He has served as associate professor of undergraduate and graduate students in the Human Anatomy Department since 2008. He was Secretary for Educational Research in the Medical Education Vice-Dean's Office from May 2007 to May 2009. Social Service in Research Program Coordinator from April 2008 to 2010; The medical school's undergraduate mentoring program coordinator in the Undergraduate Vice-Dean's Office from December 2009 to December 2010. Secretary for Research in Basic Sciences in the Research Vice-Dean's Office from 2011 to present. Founder and General Coordinator of the Research Group Anatomy (GIA) from 2003 to present, in which undergraduate and graduate students, as well as professors, participate actively. Coordinator of the Human Anatomy Undergraduate Course; He has also promoted research among undergraduate students of the school of medicine, through the founding of a Research Undergraduate Scholars Program (From 2012 to present); He is an active member of the Consolidated Morphology Academic Body appointed by the Undersecretariat of Higher Education of the General Directorate of Higher University Education. (SEP), Member of the Self-evaluation Committee for the accreditation of the Mexican Council of Accreditation of Medical Education, A.C. (COMAEM).

He has participated in more than 100 conferences and specialization courses at a national and international level. Has 70 publications between published papers in peer-reviewed journals, chapters in textbooks; besides being the author of different textbooks such as: *Anatomía Humana en Casos Clínicos, aprendizaje centrado en el razonamiento clínico*", *"Neuroanatomía 2da. Edición"*, *"Texto Atlas de Histología Biología Celular y Tisular"*, *Libro "Viñetas Clínicas ARM" para aspirantes a residencias médicas*, *"Anatomía Humana. Ciencia y razonamiento clínico"*, *"Anatomía Humana en Casos Clínicos. Aprendizaje basado en el razonamiento clínico 4ta edición"*, among others.

He has been advisor, director or co-director of several a master's and doctorate's thesis, as well as a reviewer of papers in Clinical Anatomy Medical Education and Anatomical Science Education. He has been granted a Utility Model by the IMPI. Has received 2 awards in research, one national and one International.

The areas of greatest interest in research in which he participates are "*Study of the adaptive response of vascular grafts*", "*Morphology of the main vascular conduits used as grafts*", "*Anatomical studies of minimally invasive surgical procedures*" and "*Research educational in anatomy*".

He has been a member of the American Association of Anatomist; of the Spanish Anatomical Society; of the Mexican Society of Anatomy; Editor of the News Bulletin Vesalius, official journal of the Department of Human Anatomy; as well as a member of the National System of Researchers, Level II for the period January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2021, by virtue of his achievements in carrying out original, recognized, appreciable and consistent research, as well as in the training of human resources for research.
