

Xavier Navarro received the MD degree in 1978 and the PhD degree in 1985 from the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona (UAB). He completed speciality training in Neurology at the University of Barcelona, and in Neurophysiology at the University of Minnesota. He was Assistant Professor of the Department of Neurology of the University of Minnesota (1986-1988). He returned in 1988 to the UAB as Associate Professor in the Department of Cell Biology and Physiology, where he is currently full Professor of Physiology. He has been a founder of the Institute of Neurosciences of the UAB, and director of the Department (2010-2016). Since 1989 he is heading the research Group on Neuroplasticity and Regeneration (www.npir.uab.cat). His research interests are focused on axonal regeneration, functional restitution after nerve injuries, cell and molecular therapies for spinal cord injuries, neuroprostheses, peripheral neuropathies, neuropathic pain and motoneuron diseases.
